VENDOR GUIDELINES

- Set up will occur:
 - Thursday June 18th 2026 – 2:00pm to 6:00pm
 - Friday June 19th 2026 – 6:00am to 9:00am
- Event runs daily from 10:00am – 8:00pm
- Vendors (and their helpers) will be issued a bracelet, this must be worn at all times.
- This is an outdoor event, there will be no power or wi-fi. Vendors are responsible for providing their own electricity/power.
- After unloading, all vehicles (except food trucks) must be parked in designated area.
- Food vendors will display a copy of the SFHC.
 - Bring materials that can be recycled or composted, i.e., food containers, cups, utensils etc.
- Vendors are responsible for the proper disposal of trash to the designated sites.
- If you choose to store any goods on site, GBNFC will not be responsible for damages or theft.
- All vendors are responsible for bringing their own tables, chairs, canopy, and protective rain gear.
- GBNFC will not be responsible for any personal injury or damages, nor theft or loss of equipment, goods, or products of the vendor.
- Register on-site at the Vendor Registration Booth upon arrival.
- Absolutely NO outside raffles, draws, or fundraising permitted.
- Tear down no later than 10:00am on Sunday June 21st 2026.
- Offer overnight camping for vendors who want to stay on-site in designated area (must bring your own supplies).
