We are looking to employ an Individual who is well-grounded in the Ojibwe language and Indigenous culture to teach/promote/facilitate the use of Ojibwe words, phrases, and language in the context of everyday life in a fun and exciting way. The Language Promoter will follow a workplan that includes weekly words-of-the-day for staff and users of the F.C.; teach/promote the use of the Ojibwe language in children's, youth, and adult activities. The Language Promoter will be expected to plan and organize tours to local historical Indigenous sites to give context, meaning, and incentive to learn the language.

Qualifications/Competencies:

- The candidate should have training in the Ojibwe language or lived experiences.
- The candidate should be recognized in the community as an individual who is well-versed in speaking the Ojibwe language.
- The candidate will have a sound knowledge and awareness of Indigenous culture, heritage, and history.
